## Update to MedBiquitous Fee and Proration Schedule

As of July 1, 2021, the MedBiquitous fee schedule will be updated to the model in the table below. Proration occurs at the mid-point of the fiscal year, on January 1, 2022. Those fees are represented in the column next to the full amount.
